The objective was to get filled with donations for a future goodwill store to support Prison Christian Ministries located on Riverside Drive, Fredericton, NB.

In the meantime an appeal for help with the music and preaching by PCM team member, Sherry MacMillan was answered by Rev. Murray Moore during a Cornerstone Worship Center morning service. Thus, Rev. Moore began travelling with the PCM teams. He is the executive director of Harvest House Fredericton Inc. He and his wife, Rose have been raising funds for a Drug Recovery Center for the City of Fredericton since 2018.

Meanwhile back at the 18 wheeler many, many donations were coming in and with the assistance of the President, Rev. Brent Bishop and Rev. Rosemary Blair, Operations Officer it soon became full to the brim.

Now it was up to Rev. Brent to seek a space to rent and set up the Goodwill Store but it seemed there was none available and the space he chose was not rentable. Finally in April, 2019 the table was turned and the space became available but who was Brent going to get to help him with this mammoth task?

In prayer one night a door opened when the Lord spoke to his heart.

"Have you asked Murray to help-came the Lords voice". The next day Brent was going out on ministry with Murray and he asked him for his assistance. That evening Murray and Rose Moore prayed and sought the Lord's approval with this opportunity to do the His work.

And this is how the Lord puts people with people to get His work done. Seems by chance but "no, not really".

Construction began in May, 2019 on the construction of SEED THE NEED GOODWILL STORE located at 176 Main Street, Fredericton, NB

This store joins together two ministries:

Prison Christian Ministries — which sends teams of volunteers into jails, penitentiaries, and drug recovery center in New Brunswick and Nova Scotia as well as sending funds to Kenya, Africa for a milk feeding program for the children of prisoners and also shelter for the widows of prisoners to name just a few.

Harvest House Fredericton Inc. has been attempting for 2 years to get a Recovery Center started for those addicted with various drugs, alcohol, and personality disorders just to name a few.

SEED THE NEED GOODWILL STORE will support these two very important ministries on a 50-50 basis profit wise.
